

Production Assistant

An exciting opportunity has arisen to volunteer within our media team as a Production Assistant.

The successful candidate will be part of our broadcast team, and responsible for the following:

- Helping the videographer to set up the camera, audio and streaming equipment as directed
- Starting/stopping the stream via our video platform and broadcast software
- Watching the match and initiating the on-screen graphics at the correct time
- Fixing common issues within the broadcast software

Full training will be provided for this role, as a result we are seeking someone with the ability to learn and willingness to take responsibility for their part in the broadcast.

If successful, you will work as part of a small, friendly team of volunteers, with experience in broadcasting, videography, web design and social media.

We have a number of media roles available, and would be flexible to applications for more than one role.

Skills and attributes

Essential

- Computer literate
- Attention to detail

Non-essential

- Experience of using video/audio equipment
- Experience of using OBS or other broadcasting software
- Knowledge of Stranraer FC or football generally

Benefits

As this is a volunteer role, there is no salary available.

However, as our production assistant, you will be granted free access to any first team home games you cover. Admission to these games would normally cost several hundred pounds across the season.

This is a role that would suit someone with an interest in the club, football, live broadcasting, or with a desire to pursue a career in media.

Match days only, around 4 hours.
